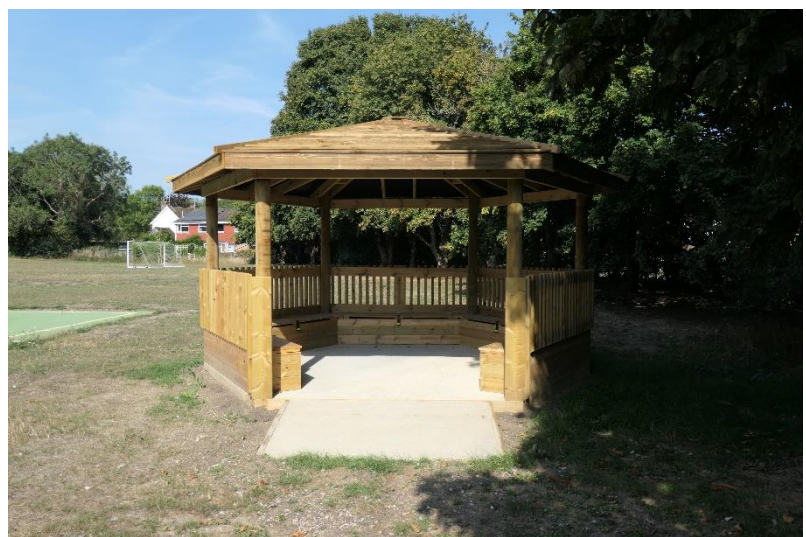


You can bring in a healthy snack each day to eat at break time. This should be a piece of fruit or some vegetables.

We will visit the library once a week. This is time when you can change your library books. There is also a space in the library which you might go and work in during some lessons.



During the week, we will have two P.E. sessions. One will be outside. Stow Sports, our Sports Coaches, will teach these lessons. On this day, you will need to wear your outdoor P.E. kit.

One will be inside, in the hall. On this day, you will need to wear your indoor P.E. kit. However, when it is cold weather, you will need to wear tracksuit bottoms and your school jumper over the top of your shorts and t-shirt.

Due to health and safety from the P.E. Association, earrings must now be removed completely for P.E. lessons – they cannot be taped over. Please make sure you remove earrings in the morning or are able to remove them yourself.



During the year, we will have Outdoor Learning sessions.

For these sessions, you will need to wear your outdoor P.E. and make sure you have long trousers and a long sleeved top. These must be in school colours.

You will also need a waterproof coat and your welly boots. Welly boots are kept on the class welly rack. Please make sure they are clearly named.
